# Installing

---

## Windows

- 1. Double-click *Setup.exe*, which can be found in the folder where you expanded the downloaded file.**

The *Setup* dialog will be displayed.

### NOTE

- A user account with administrative privileges must be used for installation.
- If the *User Account Control* window is displayed, click either *Yes* or *Continue*.

- 2. Follow the instructions displayed to install *Yamaha Expansion Manager*.**

## Mac

- 1. Double-click *YamahaExpansionManagerInstaller.pkg*, which can be found in the folder where you expanded the downloaded file.**

The *Setup* dialog will be displayed.

- 2. Follow the instructions displayed to install *Yamaha Expansion Manager*.**

# Uninstalling

### NOTE

Menu and button names may vary depending on the operating system you are using.

## Windows

Click *Control Panel > Programs* or *Uninstall a program*. Select the program you wish to uninstall, and then click *Uninstall/Change*. Follow the instructions from the displayed dialog to uninstall the application. If the *User Account Control* window is displayed, click either *Yes* or *Continue*.

## Mac

**Delete *Expansion Manager* from the Yamaha folder in Applications.**

Double-click *Expansion Manager* from the Yamaha folder in Applications.
